#### SANGGUNIANG KABATAAN MANDATORY TRAINING FOR THE NEWLY APPOINTED SK TREASURER

The newly appointed SK Treasurer of Brgy. Poblacion and Brgy. Malabanban Norte has undergone the SK Mandatory Training and Oath taking last March 18, 2021. The training was facilitated by the Local Youth Development Officer and other Chief officers from different offices. The Oath taking was administered by Hon. Vice Mayor George D. Suayan.

## PROPOSAL OF PROJECTS / PLANS AND ACTIVITIES TO BE IMPLEMENTED FOR THE 3<sup>RD</sup> QUARTER

Distribution of pocket Wi-Fi for students in Candelaria aimed to provide internet access for
the enrolled students here in Candelaria who can't afford to avail monthly bill for internet
and who is not capable to have stable internet connection in their own homes. Stable
internet connection is one of the necessities of the students nowadays in studying in the
new normal environment.

In solution to those concerns, Mr. Jan Ralf Clifford G. Arlantico (Primary Representative) proposed a project to the council targeting to distribute pocket Wi-Fi for enrolled students for every barangay here in Candelaria so that this concern will be lessened.

It was agreed upon by all members that the detailed activity design for the "DISTRIBUTION OF POCKET WI-FI FOR ENROLLED STUDENTS IN CANDELARIA" project will be discussed in the 3<sup>rd</sup> Quarter meeting, seconded by Mr. Mark David Prado (Primary Representative), with no objections and was approved.

 Distribution of school supplies for students in Candelaria aimed to provide basic material needs for the enrolled students in Candelaria who are studying in the new normal environment. This school supply is one of the necessities of the students in studying. Also, this is one of the concerns of the students because of lack of finances to provide this necessity.

In solution to this concerns Mr. Mark David Prado (Primary Representative) proposed a project targeting to distribute school supplies for enrolled students in every barangay in Candelaria so that this concern will be lessened.

It was agreed upon by all members that the detailed activity design for the "DISTRIBUTION OF SCHOOL SUPPLIES FOR ENROLLED STUDENTS IN CANDELARIA" project will be discussed in the 3<sup>rd</sup> Quarter meeting, seconded by Mr. Andreu M. De Chavez (Primary Representative), with no objections and was approved.

 COVID-19 pandemic resulted to a substantial increase in unemployment and underemployment rates, negatively affecting household incomes, as well as causing food accessibility issues. The effects of COVID-19 containment measures also contributed to reduced productivity and disruptions in the flow of goods (including food products and other essential items) for small and medium enterprises in the food-manufacturing sector which affected food availability and accessibility. Despite of challenges, the agriculture sector is expected to play a major role in the COVID-19 pandemic recovery efforts.

Mr. Radel D. Matibag (Primary Representative) proposed a training / orientation which will focus on the establishment of youth community food gardens that will promote and encourage youth participation in food production thereby contribute to food security of the municipality.

It was agreed upon by all members that the detailed activity design for the "TRAINING / ORIENTATION ON ESTABLISHING YOUTH COMMUNITY FOOD GARDENS" project will be discussed in the 3<sup>rd</sup> Quarter meeting, seconded by Mr. Jose D. Tolentino (Primary Representative), with no objections and was approved.
